COSTUMES

- Prepare your costumes- Dancers will receive costumes in class. Each costume will have an instruction paper which includes specific preparation of costume, required tights, shoes, hair, and make-up. Please prepare your costume per instructions before photo day.
- Purchase your tights & shoes and any extras needed BEFORE Photo Week. It is always good to have an extra pair of tights!
- Check the tights list in the store to be sure you have the right tights.

\$15 per seat- Saturday 11am & 4pm performances

- Know your assigned photo day & time
- Be on time for assigned Photo.
- Prepare your costume before photo days.
- Please come ready with hair and make-up done and dressed in your first costume.
- Due to COVID restrictions, space and crowds are limited. All dancers & parents should come at their assigned time only and must be masked during changing and while in line for photos.
- Only one Parent will be allowed in the building with each dancer during assigned time. No additional siblings. Parents must be masked and maintain social distancing and remain with their dancer.
- Dancers will not be allowed to wait longer than 1 hour at the studio between additional photos.
- Dressing areas will be assigned to specific groups and social distancing must be maintained while in changing areas and while in line for pictures.

DRESS REHEARSALS-

Dress rehearsals are scheduled for June 1, 2 & 3, Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday. Please refer to the Dress Rehearsal schedule Your assigned dress rehearsal is required for participation in the performance(s).

SHOW DATES- There are 6 different performances with limited seating

Friday, June 4 @ 7pm, Saturday, June 5 @ 11am, 4pm, & 7pm

Sunday, June 6 @ 2pm & 7pm

- Be ready in assigned room backstage 30 minutes before show time. Dancer should be completely dressed in first costume
- Moms remain with little ones until 10 minutes before show time.
- Moms please Set up dancer's "area"- clean snacks, toys, blankets
- If costume changes- each piece should be labeled and contained in a hanging garment bag or tote.
- Do NOT leave extra make up with little ones!
- No additional friends, family, or siblings are allowed backstage in dressing rooms.
- All Moms should be masked at all times
